### Red Bird

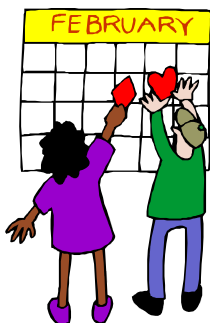

from 5:00 pm to 8:00 pm. Proceeds to benefit youth mission trip 2010.

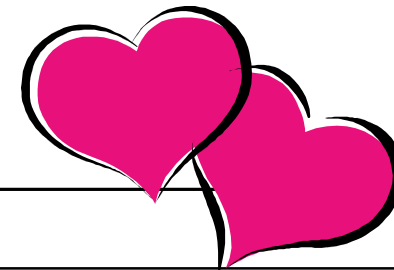
